

Rules and Course of Fire for Club Day Events on 2017 Brisbane BGR Calendar (reduced course of fire events)

Small Vermin: Rook & Rabbit

.22 caliber rimfire rifle (there is no reduced course of fire for The Small Vermin or Rook & Rabbit events)

Cartridges required:

Rook & Rabbit qualifying calibers are:-380 Rook, 300 Rook, 310 Cadel, 32/20, 25/20, must use lead bullets only

20

50 m = 5 shots sitting in 5 min
25 m = 5 shots standing in 50 sec (5 shots standing post in 5 min (No post rest for Rook & Rabbit))

25 m = 5 shots standing in 25 sec (5 x 1 shot in 3 sec for Rook & Rabbit)

Light Nitro Minimum caliber .224". Classic Cartridge: any caliber > .228 introduced as a factory round before 1939.
100 m = 3 shots standing in 3 min
50 m = 3 shots standing in 90 sec
25 m = 3 shots standing in 15 sec (Please note Pot Rifle is any sporting centrefire rifle).

Group 1 Nitro Black Powder Exp (BPE) & Pot Rifle

Minimum caliber .330", minimum bullet weight 165 grains, minimum m/e 2900 ft/lbs
Minimum caliber .400", permitted bullet weight 230 to 270 grains, minimum mv 1600 fps.

Caliber .450", minimum bullet weight 270 to 365 grains, minimum mv 1600 fps.
Caliber .500", minimum bullet weight 340 to 480 grains, minimum mv 1600 fps.

Caliber .577", minimum bullet weight 520 to 610 grains, minimum mv 1600 fps.
Min powder charge 110 grains, loads must be min 80% black powder

Jacketed bullets only allowed if loads are 100% Black Powder, **Open sights only for BPE.**
Pot Rifle is any sporting centrefire rifle

100 m = 2 shots standing in 3 min
50 m = 2 shots standing in 2 min
25 m = 2 x 2 shots standing in 10 seconds

Group 2 Nitro

Minimum caliber .400", minimum bullet weight 400 grains, minimum m/e 3900 ft/lbs.
100 m = 2 shots standing in 3 min
50 m = 2 shots standing in 3 min
25 m = 2 x 2 shots standing in 10 sec

Bore Guns BP Stopper

Minimum caliber 16 bore, must be factory max or equivalent loads. **(Open sights only)**
50 m = 4 shots standing in 5 min
25 m = 2 x 2 shots standing in 10 sec

Group 3 Nitro: & Nitro Stopper

Minimum caliber .485", minimum bullet weight 525 grains, minimum m/e 5300 ft/lbs.
100m = 2 shots standing in 5 min
50 m = 2 shots standing in 10 seconds

Charging Animal:

Minimum Group 1 Nitro 2 shots standing each at 75, 50, and 25 m in a total of 35 sec
Minimum Group 1 Nitro 25 m = 8 shots standing in a total of 35 sec

Special Snap:

Minimum Group 1 Nitro 25 m = 8 shots standing in a total of 35 sec

Double Rifle:

Stalking minimum caliber .284", minimum bullet weight 140 grains, minimum m/e 2100 ft/lbs
Stopping min caliber is Group 2 equivalent **Open** – any centrefire double rifle
50m = 4 shots standing in 16 sec
25 m = 4 shots standing in 16 sec

African Plains Rifle

Minimum caliber .264", minimum bullet weight 120 grains. **(Does not need to be magnum caliber for club events)**
200m = 3 shots standing post in 3 min
100m = 3 shots standing in 3 min
50m = 3 shots standing in 15 seconds

Pete's Special:

Minimum Group 1 Nitro. No more than 3 rounds in the rifle at any time.
3 shots standing at each 50 and 25 m, as fast as can safely manage.
Scoring = Points divided by time taken then multiplied by power factor of class used.
Power factors: Group 1 = 20, Group 2 = 27, Group 3 = 37 (Cartridges for reload to be on person)

Hayley's Hop

Minimum Group 1 Nitro. No more than 2 rounds in the rifle at any time.
2 shots standing at each 50, 30 and 15 m, as fast as can safely manage. **Open sights only.**
Scoring = Bonus points added based on class used, then total score divided by time taken.
Bonus points: Group 1 = 0, Group 2 = 3, Group 3 = 5 (Cartridges for reload to be on person)

All rifles are to be within the spirit of the event. Old scope penalty rules apply. No slings, no rests, no spotting scopes, no coaching, no changes to the reticule, or sighting system allowed during the course of an event.

Competitors will be shot as time permits. Please bring a stapler and help with targets. Non qualifying rifles sights & calibers may be used but with no eligibility for awards.

Rules and Course of Fire for National or State Postal Events on 2017 Brisbane BGR Calendar (full course of fire events)

Cartridges required:

Small Vermin: .22 caliber rimfire rifle (Rook & Rabbit 380 Rook, 310 Cadet, 32/20, 25/20 lead bullets only) 20

Rook & Rabbit: 50 m = 5 shots sitting in 5 min 5 shots standing post in 5 min (No post rest for Rook & Rabbit)

25 m = 5 shots standing in 50 sec (5 shots standing in 5 min for Rook & Rabbit)

Light Nitro: Minimum caliber .228" Classic Cartridge - introduced as factory cartridge before 1939

100 m = 4 shots standing in 5 min 4 shots sitting or kneeling in 5 min 20

50 m = 4 shots standing in 3 min 2 shots standing in 10 sec

25 m = 3 x 2 shots standing in 10 sec (Note difference in Caliber for Light Nitro to stub dry events)

Group 1 Nitro Black Powder Exp (BP/E) & Pot Rifle: Minimum caliber .330", minimum bullet weight 165 grains, minimum m/e 2900 ft/lbs 20

Minimum caliber .400", permitted bullet weight 230 to 270 grains, minimum mv 1600 fps.

Caliber .450", minimum bullet weight 270 to 365 grains, minimum mv 1600 fps.

Caliber .500", minimum bullet weight 340 to 480 grains, minimum mv 1600 fps.

Caliber .577", minimum bullet weight 520 to 610 grains, minimum mv 1600 fps.

Min powder charge 110 grains, loads must be min 80% black powder

Jacketed bullets only allowed if loads are 100% Black Powder. **Open sights only for BP/E.**

Pot Rifle is any sporting centrefire rifle.

100 m = 4 shots standing in 5 min 4 shots sitting or kneeling in 5 min

50 m = 4 shots standing in 5 min 2 shots standing in 10 sec

25 m = 3 x 2 shots standing in 10 sec

Group 2 Nitro: Minimum caliber .400", minimum bullet weight 400 grains, minimum m/e 3900 ft/lbs. 14

100 m = 2 shots standing in 5 min 2 shots sitting or kneeling in 5 min

50 m = 2 shots standing in 5 min 2 shots standing in 10 sec

25 m = 3 x 2 shots standing in 10 sec

Bore Guns BP Stopper: Minimum caliber 16 bore, must be factory max or equivalent loads. **Open sights only** 14

100m = 2 shots standing in 5 min 2 shots sitting or kneeling in 5 min

50 m = 2 shots standing in 5 min 2 shots standing in 10 sec

Group 3 Nitro: Minimum caliber .485", minimum bullet weight 525 grains, minimum m/e 5300 ft/lbs. 8

100m = 2 shots standing in 5 min

50 m = 2 shots standing in 10 Seconds (The course of fire for Nitro stopper is 6 shots in 25 sec at 25m)

Charging Animal: Minimum Group 1 Nitro 2 shots standing each at 75, 50, and 25 m in a total of 35 sec 6

Special Snap: Minimum Group 1 Nitro 25 m = 8 shots standing in a total of 35 sec 8

Double Rifle: **Stalking** minimum caliber .284" minimum bullet weight 140 grains, minimum m/e 2100 ft/lbs 14/10

Stopping min caliber is Group 2 equivalent **Open** - any centrefire double rifle

100 m = 2 shots standing in 5 min 2 shots sitting or kneeling in 5 min (100m for **Stalking Double Rifle** Nations rules only)

50 m = 2 shots standing in 5 min 4 shots standing in 16 sec

25 m = 4 shots standing in 16 sec

African Plains Rifle: Minimum caliber .264", minimum bullet weight 120 grains, minimum m/e 2000 ft/lbs must be magnum calibers 20

200m = 4 shots standing post in 5 min 4 shots sitting post in 5 min

100m = 4 shots standing in 5 min 4 shots sitting in 5 min

50m = 4 shots standing in 20 seconds

Pete's Special: Individually timed event. Minimum Group 1 Nitro. No more than 3 rounds in the rifle at any time. 6

3 shots standing at each 50 and 25 m, as fast as can safely manage.

Scoring = Points divided by time taken then multiplied by power factor of class used.

Power factors: Group 1 = 20, Group 2 = 27, Group 3 = 37

Hayley's Hop: Individually timed event. Minimum Group 1 Nitro. No more than 2 rounds in the rifle at any time. 6

2 shots standing at each 50, 30 and 15 m, as fast as can safely manage. **Open sights only.**

Scoring = Bonus points added based on class used, then total score divided by time taken.

Bonus points: Group 1 = 0, Group 2 = 3, Group 3 = 5

All rifles are to be within the spirit of the event. Scope penalty rules apply. No slings, no rests, no spotting scopes, no coaching, no changes to the reticule, or sighting system allowed during the course of an event.

Competitions will be shot as time permits. Please bring a stapler and help with targets. Non qualifying rifles sights & calibers may be used but with no eligibility for awards.

Medal Awards, and Aggregate calculations

At the end of the year, following the conclusion of the December event, we will retire to the clubhouse for some refreshments, and the presentation of our annual club awards. Medals for event listed below will be awarded based on the following considerations.

Small Vermin & Rook & Rabbit

No medals will be awarded, as these are not a big game calibers.

However the aggregate based on the best 5 results out of the 10 events for small vermin & the best 2 out of 3 for Rook & Rabbit held from February to November inclusive will be calculated, and the top 3 will be announced.

Pete's Special

Medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd will be presented based on the best 3 results out of the 5 events held from February to November inclusive

Hayley's Hop

Medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd will be presented based on the best 3 results out of the 5 events held from February to November inclusive

Light Nitro, Classic Cartridge

Medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd will be presented based on the best 2 results out of the 4 events held from February to November inclusive

African Plains Rifle

Medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd will be presented based on the best 2 results out of the 3 events held from February to November inclusive

Charging Animal & Special Snap

Medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd will be presented based on the best 3 results out of the 5 events of (both formats combined) held from February to November inclusive

Double Rifle

Medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd will be presented based on the best 2 results out of the 4 events held from February to November inclusive

Black Powder Express & Bore Guns

Medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd will be presented based on the best 2 results (must have one from each event) out of the 3 Bore Gun & 3 Black Powder Express events held from Feb to Nov inclusive

Group 1

Medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd will be presented based on the best 2 results out of the 5 events held from February to November inclusive

Group 2

Medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd will be presented based on the best 2 results out of the 4 events held from February to November inclusive

Group 3

Medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd will be presented based on the best 2 results out of the 5 events (includes all Group 3 & Nitro Stopper events) held from February to November inclusive

Ladies Champion:- The annual ladies trophy will be based on the best two aggregates scores through the year.

Junior Champion <15:- The annual <15 Juniors trophy will be based on the best two aggregates scores through the year.

Juniors Champion 15 & < 18:- The annual 15 & <18 Juniors trophy will be based on the best two aggregates scores through the year.

Ladies and Juniors champions will be awarded provided that at least three ladies/juniors compete in at least two events per month during two different months during the year

1st and 2nd will be awarded provided that at least two events per month during two different months during the year.

1st 2nd and 3rd will be awarded provided that at least four ladies/juniors compete in at least two events per month during two different months during the year.

Ladies and Juniors may compete in any event with any caliber rifle, but will gain bonus points per event for using bigger calibers: 0.5 points per shot (pps) for Group 1, 1 pps for Group 2, and 2 pps for Group 3.

Overall Aggregate (Club Champion)Medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd will be presented based on the best 4 monthly aggregate results from February to November inclusive. The monthly aggregates are calculated on the best 2 percentage results shot in each month, excluding, Small Vermin Rook & Rabbit, Pete's Special, and Hayley's Hop events. However only two aggregates can come from the months April, July or October.

This is to avoid people winning on the strength of Light Nitro & African Plains Rifle (smaller caliber) results. The other two aggregates (or all four) must (may) come from the months February, March, May, June, August, September and November. This is to ensure that Group 1, Group 2 and Group 3 class events feature in the overall aggregate.
