TO: SSAA BRISBANE MEMBERS AND GUESTS

Further to all previous updates, we advise that the range is open and continues to operate via the online booking system. New sessions available for bookings are released via the online booking system each Tuesday at 10.00am for the following timeslots.

**Thursday – Senior's Day Over 65 years – 1.00pm – 4.00pm**

**Friday, Saturday & Sunday – 3 sessions per day – 8.00am; 11.00am; 2.00pm**

**Monday – 1.00pm – 4.15pm**

**Wednesday opening to be advised in the near future.**

The rifle range and clay thrower are open to all licensed shooters. Bookings are essential via our online booking system with a non-refundable \$5.00 booking fee payable.

The 50m pistol range is open for practice to SSAA Brisbane Pistol Section members only with Level 1 RO and Category H licence. Bookings are essential via our online booking system. A booking fee is not applicable for pistol section members when reserving a timeslot.

Positions are now available on the rifle range for Category AB licensed persons wanting to bring one unlicensed guest to the range. The licensed person must have held their Category AB license for a minimum of 12 months. Time slots are available on Friday and Sunday afternoons at 2.00pm only. To make an online booking, the licensed person books a position on the RifleBench (MBA or NMB) area, and the unlicensed person books a position on the Standing Post Area (SPA). The \$5.00 booking fee will apply to each person to reserve the positions and collect the contact tracing information as required by Queensland Health.

### FOR SSAA BRISBANE PISTOL SECTION MEMBERS AND ANNUAL RANGE PASS HOLDERS

We advise that pistol section renewals and annual range pass renewals have been delayed and it is anticipated they will be emailed or posted in the coming week. All renewals will be completed online. For members who do not have access to the online system will be able to attend the office (Tuesday to Friday 9.00am-4.00pm) for assistance in completing their renewal. Payments by EFTPOS are preferred. If paying by cash correct amount must be tendered as no change is given.

Briefings with shoot captains continue on re-scheduling competitions to comply with the COVIDSafe Plan and members will be able to book to attend a competition via the new online booking system soon.

### FOR SSAA BRISBANE PISTOL SECTION MEMBERS ONLY

The Trainee Shoot for pistol section members continues on Thursday evenings at 6.00pm. The Trainee Shoot is suitable for unlicensed and licensed pistol section members wanting to complete the Notice of Competency (Grey Sheet) to be signed off as competent & enable them to apply for their Cat H licence and/or purchase the handgun of their choice. The Trainee Shoot is running both rimfire and centrefire shoots and attendance is by booking via the online system. The fee payable at the time of booking covers the cost of ammunition and club firearms. Rimfire semi-auto session is \$10.00 per session, and centrefire semi-auto or revolver is \$40.00 per session. Book via the online system.

The Level 1 RO course for our pistol section members continues. The course is for SSAA Brisbane Pistol Section members who are Cat H licensed to enable them to attend the pistol range for practice. Book via the online system.

To help keep everyone safe, a reminder that during COVID restrictions if you are feeling unwell, do not attend the range. Anyone showing symptoms of a cold or feeling unwell will be asked to leave immediately.
